Child Maltreatment Deaths Continue increasing in Sacramento County
Child Death Report to be presented to Board of Supervisors

SACRAMENTO – Child deaths from abuse and neglect have doubled in Sacramento County since 2004, according to the latest Child Death Report to be presented to the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors tomorrow, Tuesday, September 11.

“We’re seeing a very disturbing and preventable increase in child maltreatment deaths at the same time budget challenges are reducing the funding available for child protection programs,” says Sheila Anderson, President and CEO of the Child Abuse Prevention Center (CAPC) of Sacramento, who will be presenting the report.
