- Clear tables, pick-up glasses, plates and trash
- · Wash and dry dishes

- Replenish self-serve snack bowls, help plate food
- Restock the restrooms, as needed

We will need volunteers who can help with the following tasks after the event at 8:30 p.m.:

- Clear tables, pick-up glasses, plates and trash
- Take trash bags to dumpster on ranch
- Collect linen from tables
- Place rental items in crates (silverware, wine glasses, and platters)
- Wash and dry dishes
- · Break down card board boxes
- Fold chairs and tables, stack neatly
- Collect event signage
