What is the intent? Yes, helps to identify which services are not being utilized ○ Add “None”, “Other: __”, “I don’t know”, and “I prefer not to answer” to all questions where it makes sense. ○ “None” should be the first option. ○ Q3: Rephrase ○ Q4: Rephrase, make multiple choice, and move ○ Collapse Q5 into Q4 ○ Q5: Rephrase ● Demographics <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Add “transgender” to Gender question <p>Will continue work at the next meeting</p>	<p>All questions should be optional, but we should still offer the option “Prefer not to answer”</p> <p>Should offer “None” as an option.
