 - Ideas brainstormed in CAP Month Committee: Building Communities/Building Equitable Communities, Building Better Childhoods, Building Together, Thriving Communities, Family Strengthening
 - Be the One
 - Educational campaign on community norms and creating safe spaces for children (everyone has a responsibility for the safety of children, not just parents)
 - Safety 101 for children/Safetyville Day (collaborate with law enforcement, fire department, etc.)
 - Different themes at the end of each week, leading up to CAPC prevention resource fair
 - Youth-focused theme for preteens and teens such as self-care, mental health, etc. with separate parent guide for how to support your teen
 - Trauma-informed communities
 - Sexual assault/grooming and teen dating violence
 - Resilience symposium
 - Know the signs; how to report abuse
 - Internet safety
 - Lasting effects of child abuse (each week has a different theme/educational goal)
 - Substance abuse awareness
 - It takes a village; everyone has a role in prevention
 - Partner with Earth Day festivities

We could reinvest funding into pre-school education and college education for our children and youth. We would have an opportunity to set up more children for success all the way into adulthood, and then....just imagine the possibilities! ○ Include costs of homelessness prevention ○ Separate title headings – “costs” and “opportunities for prevention” ○ Provide resources/citations ○ Utilize graphs and bullet points
