Every year the CAP Center:

- Provides prevention services that have resulted in a 96% reduction in child abuse cases among the families we serve.
- Helps 15,000 youth and parents at our 80 different sites — providing foster youth mentoring, parent education, school readiness and other family support services.
- Conducts 3,000 home visits — empowering at-risk families by providing parents with nurturing, empathy and resiliency skills.
- Mentors 500 foster youth in education and life skills—90% of our foster youth graduate from high school (compared to 50% for foster youth not served).
- Trains 3,300 individuals as Mandated Reporters — including school personnel, clergy, day care operators, volunteers and others.
- Trains parents and providers on infant sleep-related deaths—resulting in a 50% reduction in infant sleep-related deaths.
- Advocates for policies that strengthen California children, families and communities.



We know how to prevent child abuse. We aren't searching for answers or a cure – education and training protect children. For \$1,200 a year, prevention services can be applied and save the life of a child.
